Norway Spruce (<i>Picea abies</i>)	(12-20") INCHES 2 Yr. transplant	10 for \$20		

A graceful pyramidal evergreen has sharp, shiny, dark needles. Slow growth rate, but will reach 60 to 80 ft. tall with a 25 to 35 ft. spread. Hardy tree that can grow in sandy, clay or loamy soils. Requires full sun. Makes a charming Christmas tree, an appealing ornamental specimen, or a protective windbreak.

Eastern White Pine (<i>Pinus strobus</i>)	(12-18") INCHES 4 Yr. transplant	10 for \$20		
--	---	--------------------	--	--

A very hardy pine grows stately and gracefully tall. Needles are soft and bluish-green in color. Bark is thin, smooth and greenish-brown, turning darker as trees mature. It has average growth rate, with adequate moisture, growth can be 50 to 75 ft. tall, with 25 to 35 ft. spread. Needs partial shade to full sun light. Grows better in sandy and loamy soils. Ideal for specimen planting, shade windbreaks and appealing Christmas Trees.

American Arborvitae (<i>Thuja occidentalis</i>)	(12-20") INCHES 4 Yr. transplant	10 for \$20

A pyramidal evergreen with foliage varying from dark green to light green during growing season. Hardy, easily transplanted evergreen. Grows best in loamy moist soil. Excellent for screens and tall hedges. Easily sheared. Slow grower but will reach 25 to 40 Ft. tall with a 10 to 15 ft. spread. Needs partial shade to full sun light.

Persimmon (<i>Diospyros virginiana</i>)	(12-18") INCHES 2 YR. seedling	TEMPORARY UNAVAILABLE		

Grows to 50 ft. tall with a 15 to 25 ft. spread. This native tree does well in difficult and extremely dry soils. Needs full sun. Fragrant white flowers in spring yield orange edible fruit in the fall.

American Elderberry (<i>Sambucus canadensis</i>)	(24-36") INCHES 2 YR. seedling	1 for \$3.00

Grows to 10 to 15 ft. tall with a 6 to 10 ft. spread. Multi-stemmed shrub with large, flat-topped white flowers in June - July followed by purple-black berries. Can be used for jellies, pies and wine. Excellent for attracting birds. Grows in sandy, clay or loamy soils. Needs full sun light.

Butternut-White Walnut (<i>Juglans cinerea</i>)	(24-36") INCHES 2 YR. seedling	1 for \$3.00

Grows to 40 to 70 ft. tall with a 45 to 55 ft. spread. Needs full sun light and will grow in sandy, clay or loamy soils. Nuts resemble Black Walnut, but smaller, with an oily, spicy flavor. Tree is best known for the rich quality of its wood.

Pears: Sunrise/AC Harrow Sweet (CAN NOT SEPARATE)	4-5 FEET	1 pair for \$30		

Sunrise: A disease-resistant pear. It has shown impressive resistance to fire blight. The fruit color is yellow, often finishing with a slight blush and very little russet. Maturity date is August 5.

AC Harrow Sweet: This variety has shown very good resistance to fire blight. A large, heavy-bearing variety with excellent quality. It does develop an attractive blush. Trees should be thinned to maintain fruit size and avoid biennial bearing. Maturity date is mid-September. Both Sunrise and AC Harrow Sweet approximate height will be 10 feet.

Yellow Peach: Cresthaven	4-6 FEET	1 for \$15

A very firm, highly colored variety for the late season. The fruit is yellow fleshed, freestone, and shows considerable red around the pit. The tree is winter hardy, very productive and has medium vigor. Extra fertilization is recommended to maintain tree longevity and vigor. Maturity date is August 25.
