#### **Program Eligibility**

## A. <u>Definition</u>

Pollination practices establish new pollinator habitat, manage/improve existing habitat, and increase healthy pollinator populations.

#### B. <u>Purpose</u>

Maintaining healthy pollinator communities and thriving pollinator habitats can improve water quality, provide habitat for other wildlife, and help stabilize and build soil structure. Healthy pollinator communities will be able to provide the service that they offer to crops that depend on them to produce fruits, vegetables, and nuts.

## C. <u>Policies for Practice</u>

- 1. Applicant must be a District Cooperator (a form is available upon request).
- 2. A W-9 tax form will be required with application for District tax purposes.
- 3. Cost share is available to landowner and/or farm operator (lessee).
- 4. Applicant must provide one of the following documents: Written lease for current time period, Current Farm Service Agency Farm Data Report or WVCA Operator Form. This will describe who is the owner and/or lessee.
- 5. Applicant must provide map identifying tract and field.
- 6. Applicant is ineligible for a practice reimbursement if he/she starts project before District approval.
- 7. Property must be used as a farming operation to be eligible for the program: having the potential for producing at least \$1000 of farm products annually, \$500 if farm is less than 5 acres.
- 8. Applications will be accepted from June 2, 2025 at 8am until April 3, 2026 at 4pm.
- 9. Approvals will be final on Wednesday April 15, 2026 and approvals are based upon availability of funds and based on the ranking form.
- <sup>10.</sup> All practice components must be completed by Friday, May 29, 2026 by 4pm and verified by receipts by Monday, June 1, 2026 by 4pm. No extensions will be given.

#### E. <u>Payment Rates & Limits:</u>

- 1. The maximum cost-share for this practice shall be 75% up to \$300 on a maximum of two nucleus colonies.
- 2. The payment will be made after paid invoices are received and the AEP committee has made a site visit.
- 3. The payment will be made within 45 days after CD has approved the payment at the monthly board meeting.
- 4. No duplication of federal or state cost-share shall be allowed.

#### D. **Practice Specifications:**

Nucleus colonies must be purchased according to the following guidelines:

- 1. Nuc must be sourced from West Virginia.
- 2. Nuc must be pre-inspected by WVDA.
- 3. Nuc must be at least 5 frames.
- 4. Honey and Pollen must be provided with the nuc.
- 5. Nuc must contain a new queen.
- 6. All State and local laws must be followed while transporting honeybees.

All State and local laws must be followed while operating an apiary. Such laws would include but are not limited to registration and inspection of hives. Cooperators must follow all WVDA best management practices on his/her apiary.
