#### **Definition:**

Managing soil pH through the addition of liming materials resulting in an improved environment for plant growth and soil and water conservation.

### Purpose:

This practice provides an incentive to buffer low pH soils and encourages better maintenance and management of land resources. Also, it provides soil and watershed protection by increasing nutrient uptake and retention, resulting in better plant vigor and vitality while aiding in the reduction erosion.

#### **Policies for Program:**

- Applicant must be a District Cooperator. ("Conservation Agreement" forms are available upon request).
- Program is available to landowner and/or farm operator (lessee).

- Applicant is ineligible for a practice reimbursement if he/she starts project before District approval.
- No duplication of federal or state cost-share shall be allowed.
- Property must be used for a farming operation.
- No more than two Ag. Enhancement Program applications will be accepted each year.
- Application approvals will be made based upon availability of funds and a ranking process.

#### **Policies for Practice:**

- Field must be used for harvesting hay, grazing livestock, or crop production currently.
- Soil sample results must indicate a need for lime. Dolomitic lime will only be approved for use on fields deficient in Magnesium.
- After three years, previously approved acres are eligible for additional lime if new sample result recommends an application.

#### **Practice Specifications:**

- State Conservation Committee approved standards and specifications must be followed.
- Recommendations for liming rates will come from WVU Extension Service, Certified Soil Laboratory Results, or a WV
  Certified Nutrient Management Planner.
- The agricultural liming material(s) used for this practice must be **<u>REGISTERED</u>** with the West Virginia Department of Agriculture to be eligible for reimbursement. (A current list is available upon request).
- The lime must be <u>purchased</u> and <u>spread</u> no later than <u>May 04, 2026</u>.

#### **Reimbursement Process:**

- A payment will be approved as: 1. Receipts are received; 2. Verification form is signed: 3. District approves the payment.
- All receipts and forms are due to the Monongahela Conservation District Office by <u>May 04, 2026</u>, otherwise payments may be delayed or even denied.
- Requests for deadline extension may be approved on a case-by-case basis.

#### Application must include the following:

- 1. Conservation Agreement (if applicable)
- 2. Signed application.
- 3. Farm map with individual fields and areas identified where the practice is proposed.
- 4. A current (sampled in the past 3 years) soil test result from an accredited laboratory for each field.
- 5. Lease agreement, Producer Application Form, or USDA-FSA Annual Farm Report (if applicable).
