Program Eligibility

1. Definition

1. To improve soil structure, reduce erosion, and increase the production of grassland.

2. Purpose

- 1. Provide incentive for the maintenance of grasses and /or legumes on grassland.
- 2. Provide soil and watershed protection by increasing plant vigor and vitality therefore aiding in the reduction of erosion on grassland.

3. Policies for Practice

- 1. Application signup period will be from July 5, 2023 through August 4, 2023.
- 2. Applicant must be a District Cooperator.
- 3. A W-9 tax form will be required with application for District tax purposes.
- 4. Cost share is available to owner or lessee.
- 5. Applicant must provide map identifying tract and field along with proposed acreage.
- 6. NRCS standards and specs must be followed.
- 7. Approvals will be final in the first week of September.
- 8. Application approvals will be made based upon availability of funds and based on the ranking form.
- 9. Invoices must be submitted by May 24, 2024, 4:00PM.
- 10. Care must be given to protect water quality during and after application.
- 11. Current soil tests (within past 3 years) must come from a certified laboratory.
- 12. Soil samples may be taken by any qualified or approved person, including the farmer.
- 13. Only state registered ag lime, purchased in bulk, may be used.
- 14. Lime must meet state agriculture registration requirements in order to be approved.
- 15. Fields will be on a 3- year rotation for application.
- 16. Program guidelines require publication of approved applications.
- 17. Producers are only eligible for 2 AgEP practices per Fiscal Year.
- 18. Landowner/Operator Agreement MUST be signed and returned within 45 days or funding will be forfeited.
- **19.** <u>Beginning Fiscal Year 2023-24, cooperators must complete ALL practices that they are approved for, or they will be ineligible to apply for 1 year.</u>

4. Payment rates & limits:

- 1. The maximum cost-share for this practice shall be at a 60% rate up to \$50.00 per ton maximum on Hay and Pasture only.
- 2. Not to exceed \$30.00 a ton cost share payment.

- 3. Cost-sharing is authorized for purchase, delivery, and application of necessary lime for maintenance of permanent grasses, legumes on pasture and hay land.
- Maximum of 50 acres per applicant. 4.
- 5. The payment will be made within 45 days after paid invoices are received, cooperator completes a W-9 form and the AEP committee has made a site visit.
- 6. No duplication of federal or state cost-share shall be allowed.
