Hay Establishment	 - Producers are eligible up to a cumulative of 50 acres per fiscal year (July to June). - Must stay in hay for 5 years. - Must have current soil tests less than (3) years old. Program Eligibility

Definition

1. Conversion of cropland to hay.

Purpose

- 1. Forage establishment is important to improve or maintain livestock nutrition and/or health. It can provide or increase forage supply during periods of low forage production. Also, by planting hay land it can reduce soil erosion and improve soil and water quality.
- 2. Optimal planting dates are August 15 through September 30, March 15 through April 15.

Policies for Practice

- 1. Application signup period will be from June 16th through July 18th, 2025.
- 2. Applicant must be a District Cooperator.
- 3. A W-9 tax form will be required with application for District tax purposes.
- 4. Cost Share is available to owner or lessee.
- 5. Applicant must provide map identifying tract and field along with proposed acreage.
- 6. NRCS standards and specs must be followed.
- 7. Approvals will be final on the **second Tuesday of August.**

- 8. Application approvals will be made based upon availability of funding and the ranking form.
- 9. Approved practice(s) must be completed, and invoices submitted to the District Office by May 29, 2026 by 4:00PM.
- 10. Applicants must provide a map identifying the tract and field along with proposed acreage.
- 11. Current soil tests (within the past 3 years) are required and must come from a certified laboratory.
- 12. Soil samples may be taken by any qualified or approved person, including the farmer.
- 13. Fields must be either spray killed and/or residue tilled under.
- 14. Field(s) must remain in hay for 5 years.
- 15. If pH is less than 5.8 for the field(s) applying, P levels are below: 12 lbs./ac, 6 PPM or 28 lbs./ac of P₂O₅, and K levels are below: 76 lbs./ac, 38 PPM or 92 lbs./ac of K₂O. **IT IS INELIGIBLE.**
- 16. Program guidelines require publication of approved applications.
- 17. Producers are only eligible for 2 AgEP practices per fiscal year.
- 18. Landowner/Operator agreement MUST be signed and returned within 45 days or funding will be forfeited.
- 19. Applicant must complete ALL AgEP practices that they are approved for, or they will be ineligible to apply for the AgEP program for 1 year.

Payment Rates & Limits

- 1. The maximum cost-share for this practice shall be a flat rate of \$125.00 per acre.
- 2. Maximum of 50 acres per applicant.
- 3. The payment will be made within 45 days after paid invoices are received, cooperator completes a W-9 form and the AgEP committee has made a site visit.
- 4. No duplication of federal or state cost-share shall be allowed.

Practice Specifications

- 1. NRCS standards and specs must be followed.
- 2. After approval, the applicant must follow job sheets provided at the time of signing the contract.
- 3. Methods of seeding stands may be established either by conventional or no till.
- 4. Fields must either be spray killed and/or residue tilled under.

By signing this I have read, understand, and agree to the terms and conditions stated in this document.

5. The lifespan of this practice is 5 years.
