## **Program Eligibility**

#### Definition

1. Heavy Use Area Protection – Concrete Pad installed at poultry house and litter shed entrances. (561)

#### **Purpose**

1. Management and containment of poultry litter and spillage during poultry catching and cleanout to minimize potential pollutants from entering adjacent waterways. Provides a solid base for heavy trucks and other equipment and negates soil erosion.

#### **Policies for Practice**

- 1. Application signup period will be from June 16th through July 18th, 2025.
- 2. Applicant must be a District Cooperator.
- 3. A W-9 tax form will be required with application for District tax purposes.
- 4. Cost Share is available to owner or lessee.
- 5. Applicant must provide map identifying tract and field along with proposed acreage.
- 6. NRCS standards and specs must be followed.
- 7. Approvals will be final on the **second Tuesday of August.**
- 8. Application approvals will be made based upon availability of funding and based on the ranking form.
- 9. Approved practice(s) must be completed, and invoices submitted to the District Office by May 29, 2026 by 4:00PM.
- 10. AEP representative will be notified prior to concrete being poured and practice will be inspected prior to payment.
- 11. Program guidelines require publication of approved applications.
- 12. Producers are only eligible for 2 AgEP practices per fiscal year.
- 13. Landowner/Operator agreement MUST be signed and returned within 45 days or funding will be forfeited.
- 14. Applicant must complete ALL AgEP practices that they are approved for, or they will be ineligible to apply for the AgEP program for 1 year.

#### **Payment Rates & Limits**

- 1. The maximum cost-share for this practice shall be \$7,500.00.
- 2. The cost share for this practice funding shall be a maximum of 2 houses with a cap of \$7,500.00 per applicant.
- 3. Cost share rates are set at a flat rate of \$9.66 sq. ft. for non-reinforced concrete (using welded wire fabric) and for rebar on 18" spacing.
- 4. The payment will be made within 45 days after paid invoices are received, cooperator completes a W-9 form and the AgEP committee has made a site visit.
- 5. No duplication of federal or state cost-share shall be allowed.
