FY27 Agricultural Enhancement Program (AgEP)
Signup Period: May 4–29, 2026, 8am-4pm, Mon/Wed/Fri

TVCD AgEP signups open May 4–29. This year, applicants have extra time before the signup window begins. We encourage cooperators to get a head start by gathering required documents to ensure a smooth application process once signups open.

Get a Head Start: Required Documents

The following items must be submitted with every application. (*Documents from previous years cannot be reused.*) Applications will not be approved without all applicable materials.

Required for all applications:

- FSA Farm Map (Find your FSA Office [HERE](#))
- [Completed Cooperator Agreement](#)
- [W-9 Form](#)

Required if applicable:

- Signed Lease (for rented land)
- [Soil Sample](#) Results
 - Note that although documents submitted in previous years cannot be reused, results of samples taken on or after 7/1/23 are acceptable if submitted with application
 - See below for practices requiring nutrient information; find your local WVU Extension office [HERE](#)

Please note: All materials must be submitted together with the application during the May 4–29 signup period. TVCD cannot accept early submissions of applications or documents. Documents submitted in previous years cannot be reused.

FY27 AgEP Practices Offered:

The following AgEP practices will be available during the upcoming signup period:

- Frost Seeding (soil sample results required)
- Lime (soil sample results required)
- Pollination
- Pollinators
- Small Scale Soil Amendment (soil sample results required)
- Urban Agriculture
- Watering System
- Invasive Species Management
- Heavy Use Area Protection

Full practice descriptions and cost-share details will be available at signup.

How to Prepare Now:

Cooperators can use the early part of the season to:

- Obtain FSA farm maps from [your local FSA office](#)
- [Collect soil samples and submit them for testing](#) (if applicable)
- Confirm lease agreements if applying on rented property
- Review which practices for which you intend to apply
- Gather tax and identification information for the W-9

Taking care of these steps ahead of time will help ensure a complete and timely application once the signup period begins.
